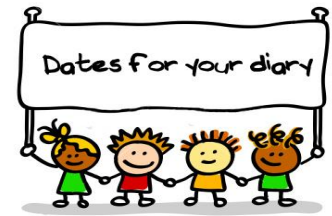
Data Collection Forms.
